#### **PARISH COUNCIL NOTES**

# Temporary Closure of The Street From 13<sup>th</sup> November and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 17<sup>th</sup> November 2017.

Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic for Southern Gas to undertake essential works: A27 The Street (Part), Whiteparish; from its iunction with Doves Lane for a distance of approximately 150m in an easterly direction. The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
