NPT Priorities

At the March meeting of our local Neighbourhood Tasking Group held in West Dean the following local Policing Priorities were identified for the forthcoming period -

- **Community Speed** Watch a NPT wide priority, assisting in the setup and running of new community speed watch initiatives area wide.
- **Vehicle crime / Thefts** from Motor Vehicles there have been a number of thefts reported at Figsbury Ring car park. The NPT will be carrying out high visibility patrols in order to inform the public and prevent any further incidents as well as investigating the crimes.

Performance Figures

Comparing figures for March 2009 to February 2010 with same period in the previous year shows that:

Figures for South Wiltshire Community Area (Alderbury and Downton)

Overall crime has fallen by 13.8% (711 to 613)

Violent Crime has fallen by 6% (101 crimes to 95)

Non Domestic Burglary (incl. Commercial) has fallen by 6% (120 to 113)

Domestic Burglary has increased by 18% (38 crimes to

Vehicle Crime has fallen by 20% (91 crimes to 73)

Robbery of Personal Property - no crimes in either year.

Shoplifting – has fallen by 33% (9 crimes to 6)

Pedal Cycle theft - an increase (8 crimes to 15)

In January 2010 the percentage Community Beat time Managers time spent working in their NPT area was 88.1% and for Police Community Support Officers the figure was 99%.
