NPT Priorities

At the November meeting of our local Neighbourhood Tasking Group the following local Policing Priorities were identified for the forthcoming period –

- **Speeding** a NPT wide priority, continuing checks in support of camera safety unit.
- NHW revitalisation. This ongoing priority is overseeing the systematic revitalisation of the NHW schemes across the area.
- **Traffic related** in line with the area board we are assisting in the issues associated with Church Road Laverstock and the schools.

Parking Issues Again!

Inconsiderate parking is the bane of many peoples lives, a moment of selfishness leads to inconvenience and potential danger to other road users and pedestrians. Outside schools at drop off and pick up is a problem that has been worsened by the recent inclement weather but can I take this opportunity to urge drivers, parents and children to all help and remind everyone of their obligations to park legally and considerately. If offences are seen we will deal with the transgressors.

Thefts from Vehicles

As we venture out as the weather gets warmer the rise in thefts from vehicles are also becoming more frequent as you can see from the reports this month. Please follow these simple guidelines. When parking, try to leave the car where it is overlooked from the road, neighbouring buildings or an area such as a picnic site where other people can act as natural guardians. Try to park near to other vehicles.

A portable Sat Nav should always be taken with you, remember to wipe away any suction pad marks left on the windscreen or dashboard, as thieves will look out for these. Don't leave Sat Navs or other valuables such as purses or handbags in the glove compartment or try to hide anything under the seat – thieves will check there first.

Lock all doors and windows, not forgetting the sunroof, when leaving your car.

Don't leave anything on view in your car.

Thieves are opportunists and it only takes a moment to break in. Remember that even an empty bag or a coat left on a back seat of a locked car can be sufficiently tempting for a thief to smash a window.
