- Only come to the surgery if you have a booked appointment or you are collecting a prescription.
- Please do not contact the surgery to enquire about COVID vaccinations. This
 will help free the phone lines for those patients that are seeking urgent
 medical advice.
- We will let you know when it is your turn to book your vaccination. The NHS is prioritising vaccinating those people who experts have agreed will benefit from it the most.
- The phone lines are exceptionally busy and our reception team are answering your calls and queries as quickly as they can. They have been receiving a lot of verbal abuse recently and this is unacceptable. Please be patient they are trying to help you!
- If you find there is a queue at the front door please adhere to social distancing.
- If you have to come to the surgery please wear a face covering.

We would like to reassure you that if you have a health concern we are still open for business.

Meanwhile, we all need to keep to the advice of hand-washing, face masks and social distancing but we all look forward to the time when we will return to life as normal.
