



Help Support Your Village Amenities

All of the village amenties on the Whiteparish Memorial Ground are managed and funded by the Whiteparish Memorial Trust. This includes the children's play area, the tennis courts/MUGA, the exercise equipment and the playing field itself as well as the Memorial Centre. The Trust also bears most of the cost of the car park (the Surgery contributes half of the cost of the lower part). We are hoping to carry out major improvements this year including a tarmac surface to the central strip which will cost more than £30,000.

Whilst the Memorial Centre and sports grounds are largely funded by hire fees, the Trust is dependent upon other sources of funding to pay for other outside facilities and the Whiteparish 100+ Club is a critical element of this

What is Whiteparish 100+ Club?

It is a village lottery which raises funds to support these village amenities. It has been running for over 30 years and typically contributes around £2000 each year towards Trust funds. But with the costs of repairing the carpark, playground and MUGA continuing to rise we need more villagers to join and help to contribute.

Membership

A year's membership of the Club costs just £15 which buys you one entry into each monthly draw and a further entry into the Christmas draw where the top prize is £100. The monthly draws currently have a top prize of £30 with further prizes of £20 and £10. The exact number and size of prizes will increase if we get a good response to this appeal - over 40% of the membership fees are paid back as prizes so there is a good chance of winning but obviously this is mainly just a bit of fun with a serious aim – to keep our village amenities going!

Like any lottery you can buy more than one ticket and many people have several to increase their chances and to contribute more to the village.

If you are already a member you may want to consider buying an extra ticket.

How does it operate?

The monthly draws are carried out in public (lockdowns permitting!) either at a Memorial Trust meeting or at a local pub. The Christmas draw is held at the Club's Christmas social event which also includes good food and drink, entertainment, a quiz and raffle.

If you win you will get an email to tell you so and the results are published in Steeple & Street and the Village website. Prizes are usually paid directly to your bank account.

OK so how do I join?

Just fill in your details overleaf and complete the Standing Order form or if you bank online you can set up the Standing Order yourself using the details in the form. Alternatively, you can pay by cheque payable to **Whiteparish Memorial Trust** though a Standing Order means you will be automatically renewed each year (and can always cancel anytime by contacting your Bank).

Return the form to Richard Burr, 5 The Bramleys, Whiteparish SP5 2TA or leave it at the village shop. Please do this by 10th June and you will then be a member for the next 100+ Club year which starts on 15th June. Richard will email you to advise you of your draw number(s).
