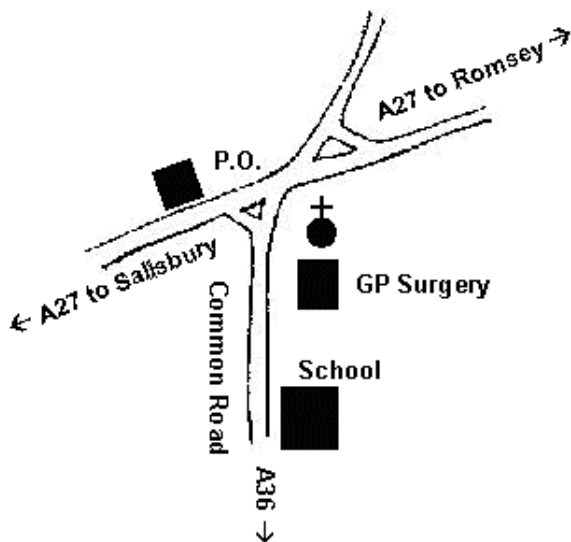


2004/05 SATS RESULTS

INTRODUCTION

Whiteparish primary school was established on its present site in 1842 as a school for all ages. Countess Elizabeth Nelson, a descendant of Admiral Nelson, presented the ground on which it was built to the village. The family has had connections with the village since the Battle of Trafalgar.

The original school building was much smaller with only one classroom. Over the years it has expanded to four well equipped classes which can accommodate up to 120 pupils.

The school also possesses excellent outdoor play facilities including a large field. There is also a separate secure play area for Foundation stage children.
