Meeting Dates 2018

Further to various village groups and Wiltshire Council meetings clashing with Parish Council meetings it was agreed to change meeting days in 2018 to Tuesday evenings whenever possible and appropriate. The list of future Parish Council meeting dates will be published shortly.

Election Update

Ten of the eleven seats for Whiteparish Parish Council were taken after nominations closed on April 4th. There is one seat remaining and this vacancy will be filled by co-option at the next Parish Council meeting on 18th May. The Wiltshire Council unitary election will take place in Whiteparish on 4th May.

Best Kept Village Competition 2017

Thank you all for your continuing hard work in keeping the village smart and tidy. Whiteparish has again been entered into the Best Kept Village competition and the first round of judging will take place between mid-May and mid-June. There are three categories and Whiteparish falls under the *large* village category; the best village in each group goes through to the County Round.
