A number of complaints have recently been received about an increase in dog fouling in Whiteparish particularly by Martins Rise, Witchell Way and Doves Lane plus footpaths in the centre of the village. Dog owners are reminded of their social and legal responsibilities to clean up dog faeces. In addition to being unsightly, smelly and unpleasant, they can carry disease.

Dog owners can also dispose of bagged dog waste in the public general purpose waste bins throughout the village, please do not hang it from bushes and trees.
