Whiteparish Parish Council is seeking to co-opt two new parish councillors. The Council meets approximately every 5 weeks, usually on a Tuesday evening at the Memorial Centre. Parish Councillors volunteer their time to work on behalf of their local community. To qualify a person must be British, or a citizen of the Commonwealth, or European Union, at least 18 years old, registered to vote in the area or have lived, worked or owned property within Whiteparish or within three miles of it, and must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor (please check with the clerk for further eligibility criteria).

Noticeboards

Two new noticeboards have been ordered from Greenbarnes to replace the existing ones opposite the shop. They are man-made timber notice boards with self-healing rubber pinboard. They should be installed within the next 8 weeks.

New recycling collection services from 30th July 2018

From 30th July 2018, you will be able to recycle plastic pots, tubs and trays and drink and food cartons. In addition to the usual plastic bottles and cardboard, you can include yoghurt pots, plastic trays, margarine tubs, ice cream tubs and juice, milk and soup cartons. These can all go in your blue lidded bin from 30th July. Please rinse and squash your recycling where possible. Remember plastic films and black plastic cannot be recycled. Collections will still be fortnightly and collection days will not change. Residents will continue to use the same containers they already have.
